- ◆ You agree to do the proper training to complete this ride and will withdraw or offer to volunteer by June 1st if you have not. There is limited sag support on this ride. Prepare to go the distance to complete the ride prior to sundown (approx. 8:00 p.m.)
- ◆ Helmets will be required without exception. We run a safe event. Ride with caution at all times.
- ◆ Riders agree to conduct themselves safely and responsibly both on and off the road. Please be considerate of people's property.
- ◆ Riders agree that the Boston to Provincetown ride is a dangerous event due to the inherent risks of cycling. Riders agree that the volunteers who run this event will not in anyway be held responsible for injuries or death of a rider or volunteer. By registering for this event and by signing this registration form you are holding harmless all those associated with the event and waive all rights to hold anyone liable for any incidents on this ride. Unsigned registration forms will be returned.
